Backyard Barbecue Competition June 5 -- Utah State Fairpark



For the regular guy who likes to cook BBQ, but rarely ventures outside the confines of his backyard, The Wild West Barbecue Showdown and The Utah BBQ Association is bringing to you the first amateur division contest. The Wild West Barbecue Showdown will be open to anyone not competing in the professional division. The Wild West Barbecue Showdown is limited to standard backyard

size grills using any type of fuel: gas, charcoal, or electric. In this division, the winner will receive a new grill provided by **Sam's Club**.

Bring any grill you have, some chicken and ribs, some flavorings, a couple of lawn chairs and some refreshments and show us your skills. The BBQ that pleases your family just might win a grill, and bragging rights of winning the first annual.

Two categories, cook them both. Pork Ribs and Chicken (any part of the chicken-usually thighs, drums, upper wings or breasts, probably not necks or gizzards, chicken lips or feet but hey...) cook them the way you like them, dry rubbed, mopped, just plain grilled, sauced or however. BYO everything, electricity you provide, water will be available nearby, but not provided to your cook space - bring buckets for cleanup and sanitation. We will check in your meat when you arrive. It must be iced, and raw (i.e. not marinated injected or pre-rubbed until after you check in. If you must cure your meat longer, check in early and you may start anytime after being checked in.) Read carefully the section on garnish and added sauces. We will provide a Styrofoam tray for you to turn in your entry. You will need to submit at least 6 separate portions (there will be 6 judges scoring your meat) in each category to be judged. Cook a few extra!
